- 3. Evaluate the most significant difference between the Protestant and Catholic Reformations.
- 4. Evaluate how the principle of religious toleration continued and changed between the time 1517-1648.
- 5. Evaluate the economic, intellectual, and religious impacts of the development of the movable-type printing press in the late 15th and early 16th century Europe.

Period 2 & 3 (1648-1914)

- 6. Evaluate the similarities in the methods that various absolute monarchs used in the 1600s and 1700s to consolidate and increase their power.
- 7. Evaluate the differences between the 1st and 2nd Industrial Revolutions
- 8. Evaluate the differences between the motives that shaped European colonial expansion in the period 1450-1750 and the motives that shaped European colonial expansion in the period 1850-1914. **Look at the handout I gave to you on this!!
- 9. Evaluate the differences between the unification of 19th century Italy and Germany.
- 10. Evaluate the most significant effect of the Agricultural Revolution between the 1600s-1700s.
